

I wanted to know more about death, and the dying process. It is a final journey we all get to make. Each stage of the dying process was explained very well, and succinctly. Practical physical and spiritual insights were presented. I wish authors would also cover euthanasia. But I understand and respect the fact that they may not wish to do so for deeply held spiritual and ethical reasons.

As a hospice volunteer, it gave me deeper insight to what is going on intimately even though one

knows what is coming next. This book is excellent to anyone with a family member to is just going into hospice and removes the unexpected so they can have a better understanding of what is going on with their loved one or friend and what we all must ultimately face at a point in our lives.

My husband had a very aggressive rare kind of lymphoma that did not respond to treatment. I needed solid information on the dying process quickly and other sources had not been specific enough. I bought this book as my husband's condition deteriorated. I read it through and realized immediately that it was comforting and yet very helpful in the details. I am so thankful that I had this book as my support as I experienced my husband's death.

I ordered this book on my Kindle while holding my dad's hand during his final hours. I had no idea what happens during the final hours of life. I felt helpless, not knowing what to do for my dad. This book helped explain the process of dying so that I could understand what was happening right in front of me.

Excellent resource. Sensitive, yet to the point. Wish I would have known about it while my sister was dying of cancer, it would have eased some of the anxiety around the process. Grief is hard enough to bear without adding fear and anxiety, this book will help with the latter. Highly recommend.
