

I have to begin my review by saying I did enjoy this book. But there was an issue that caused confusion, especially in the second chapter and a couple times later in the story, that almost

catapulted this book into my never-to-finish pile. This issue has to do with a lack of dialogue tags in key scenes where either two people of the same sex are talking, or multiple people are in the scene. I had to stop numerous times to try and parse out who was talking because, particularly in the second chapter, the lack of enough "so-and-so said" tags made it difficult to decide if I had just uncovered some shocking secret or if the author had mixed up the two characters. But, once I made it past the second chapter it was less of an issue and I only stumbled one or two other times and the rest of the story was mostly worth the confusion. The story combines lots of great elements: engaging, multi-faceted characters, a murder mystery, supernatural/mythical qualities, romance, and tons of adventure. Unfortunately I had the villain pegged the moment he stepped into a scene, but the ride was overall enjoyable and blissfully free from too much carnality. Well, beyond the nature of the crimes, a dream or two and a lewd scene with the god of wine. Overall it was a cohesive plot, which is the highest praise I can give a book in this day and age. And the story was engaging. Now, for those who care about this, as I do, it should be noted that Christianity is painted somewhat poorly in the book. This is to be expected of a book that relies so heavily on Greek and Roman mythologies, but I like to point it out in case that's something that turns you off a book.

I liked this story - but not enough to go to book #2 sadly - I may pick it up when I run out of other books to read (yeah right) but if you're into mythological gods, you may like this story/series... Story was very well written - it was more the subject I wasn't that into I guess...

I enjoyed the book. The author successfully mixed the Greek Gods into a modern story. Characters are well defined and I got an education regarding who they were in mythology. Main character (heroine, so to speak) was no nonsense and hot.
