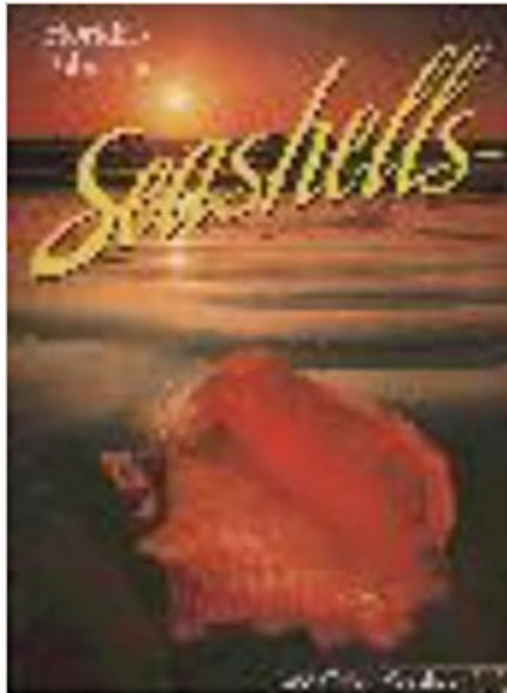

This book is great, it has a ton of amazing photos and has an excellent selection of shells so I find it to be a great reference for identifying shells I've found. Someone who spends a lot of time shelling might not find it as useful because it doesn't seem to have many of the more rare shells. It's probably best for someone who doesn't spend a lot of time shelling (like me) because it contains a lot of extra information about sea life that an experienced sheller might already know. The book was fascinating for me because I am not experienced, and I learned a lot from it.

It was stranded on the sand (the book explains why), so my husband did his manly duties and pushed it back in the water. The sea hare left a purple slime... just like the book says. This--like others in the series--is a full-sized book. It would be nicer in a pocket size. It would also be nice if it warned all shellers that at least some if not all Florida counties have outlawed taking live shells. It's so much nicer and more challenging to find a perfect shell that's empty, anyway, isn't it? If you're a budding conchologist, this is the book to buy. With this one book, I've been able to identify every shell I have found here in Florida. Makes a great gift, too.

When looking through this book I have to smile, so many of the shells are exactly as we see the when we go to FL. Although it has a lot of information it isn't so much a reference book as a beautiful picture book with information. I have three of these beautiful over sized books so far, the quality is really good and the pictures can be looked at again and again, art as well as a book.

This seashell book is all about the pictures and are they ever clear and big. They even show the mollusks in some. Like the layout of the book, too, with info sprinkled here and there. We live in Sarasota, FL, and walk Lido Beach often. Not quite like Sanibel and Captiva that have larger shells, but many of the main ones are there, as showcased in this book. Get this book. It will make you want to visit Florida and other beaches for shelling.
