

This is a great book. It is centered on the idea that you already know what the diagnosis is (there's other great differential diagnosis books out there - this isn't one of them), but assuming you got the diagnosis right, this book is a handy guide for the med student/intern who doesn't have that much experience with hospital course. When someone has a CHF exacerbation, what do you need to worry about in the first 15 minutes, first few hours, or over the course of the hospital stay? This book walks you through it and also gives you some brief background info to boot. Its probably a bit basic for the resident, but a very helpful resource for all that practical information that comes from experience but is hard to find spelled out so clearly in a reference book.
