

As an active member of the choir and occasional soloist, I appreciate having my own copy to use for reference, home practice and marking up changes. Not the sort of book everyone would buy for personal use, but if you are an active UU church member, and particularly if you are active in your music program and/or serve as a lay leader for services or church programs, this is an enormously valuable resource worth keeping at home.
