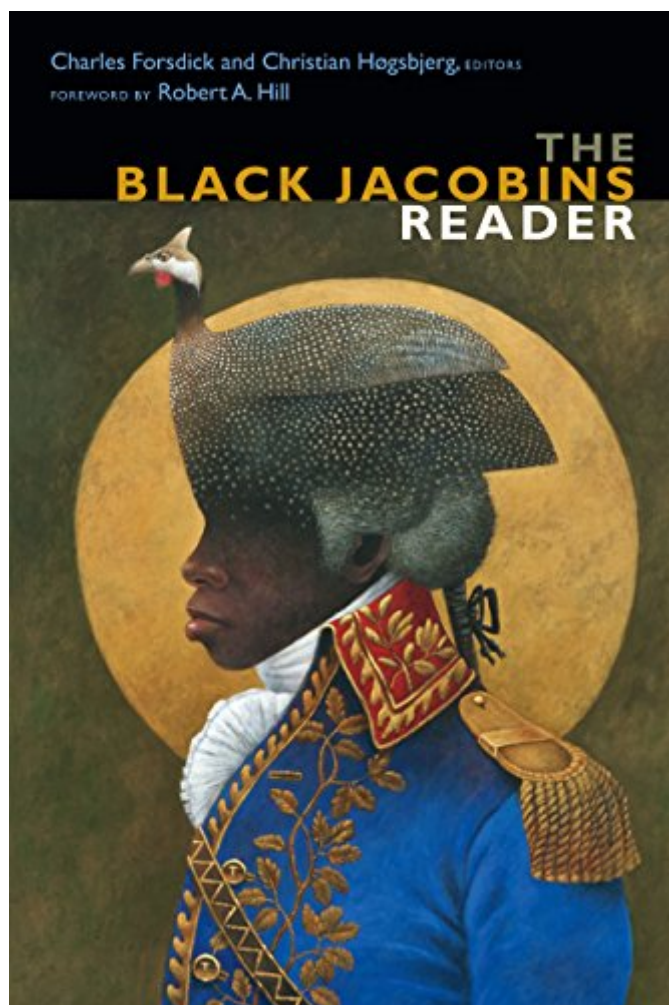

This collection of essays on CLR James's *The Black Jacobins* are very rigorous and make cutting edge contributions to historical, literary, and political analysis. Particularly valuable is the discussion of how James later in life spoke of how he wrote and might re-write his classic history of the Haitian Revolution. Many comparative readings with the French and Russian Revolutions make clear James had on his mind "the black sans-culottes" and the inability of the jacobins, french or haitian, to sustain a radical democratic outlook. The focus on the Black Jacobins in the title of the original work was meant to vindicate Toussaint and others, despite their limitations, as being intelligent as any other radical cadre or statesman in revolutionary history. But it was also a warning against the emerging Black political class and how it might repress ordinary Black people's self-government at the post-independence moment. The essays by Carolyn E Fick, Rachel Douglas and Matthew Quest are particularly insightful.
