

(Cassette tapes are SO Last Millenium.) The terrific musical theater actor Adam Bryant performs with zest and subtlety these 15 unpredictable original songs. This exuberant set is the perfect companion volume to the #1 national bestseller, Philadelphia Chickens. With lyrics and pictures by Boynton and music written with and played by the one and only Michael Ford (actually, there are probably quite a few Michael Fords, but this one is a really good musician), these songs have the style, swing, charm, and pizzazz that little listeners deserve. Read along! Sing along! Oink along! Or maybe just listen.

I first purchased this in cassette tape and book form (along with Boynton's "Philadelphia Chickens") for my kids over 15 years ago. When we were planning a trip that would have us all in the car for 25+ hours, I decided to order this again with the CD and surprise them during the trip. It was a big hit and a blast singing along to the same silly songs with my now 17 and 19 year olds. My daughter has used the sheet music in the book to play on the piano as well. Someday, I hope to share these same silly sing-alongs with my future grandkids!

Fun for children and adults! We love Sandra Boynton, but I'll admit I was hesitant to listen to this - we are kind of picky when it comes to playing "good" music for our kids. This is good! The music is funny and enjoyable, but also varied, well-written and well performed by Adam Bryant. My husband and I sing these tunes all the time (even when the kids aren't around!) Sheet music in the back of the book is a very nice bonus!
