

It's both great and strange to have a coin book that has absolutely no dates in it. Gets the job done, however, since they haven't released a book that has the latest years in it, so I have the latest coins on the left pockets and other special cents that I am stockpiling for when I complete other books and want to start a new one.

Whitman Lincoln Cents collection is a good quality folder for the new and old collectors alike. Each of its 3 pages has 30 slots for holding a total of 90 coins and for either displaying the back or some other special coins you may have. There are no labels but a space to do your own labeling is provided. Read the directions and inserting the coins is no problem. This would make a great "tooth fairy" album because it will hold whatever pennies you want to put in it. If you like to collect out of your pocket change, this is probably for you =)

The Lincoln plain folders do what they are designed to do. It allows me to organize my cents any way I choose. Coins are easy to put in and well made. Nice way to display my coins. I can also easily take out a coin and replace it with a better conditioned one if I want to. Good folder.

These are great for my extra wheat pennies. Holds my pennies in place.

Nice that this was blank so we could label the slots where the other coin holder left off. The pennies are harder to insert though. With just a tap from a small hammer (after placing something soft over the coin) the coin fit fine in the slot.

I wanted a penny book that did not have years on it and this looks like it will work well.
