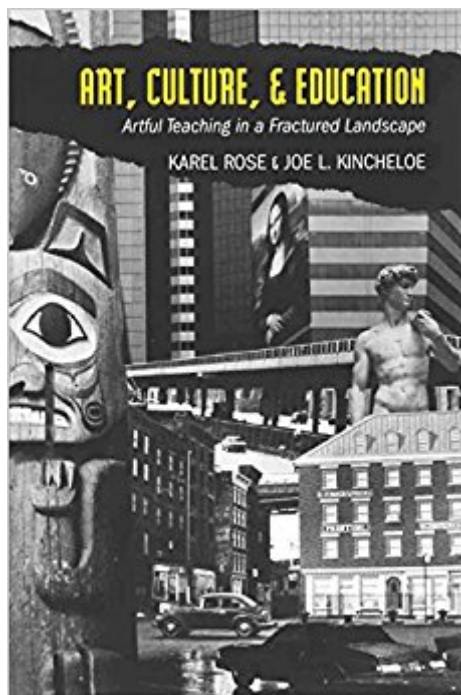




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# Art, Culture, & Education: Artful Teaching In A Fractured Landscape (Counterpoints)
