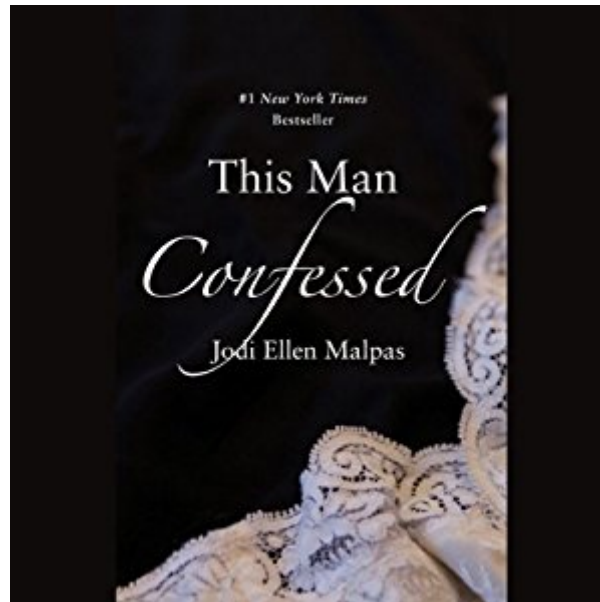

I have absolutely loved all three books in this series. Jesse is definitely swoon-worthy and I loved his interactions with Ava, ranging from over the top romantic to extremely frustrating! I'm so sad that this is the end of their story but glad they got their happily ever after. I would have given five stars if it wasn't for the bad job of editing that was done which really detracted from the story for me. Most of the time with indie authors, you expect some editing issues, which there were some in the first two books. When an author signs with a publishing house and release dates get pushed back, you expect that the editing will improve. Unfortunately that was not the case here. I felt the editing was actually the worst in this book out of all three of them and as a result I couldn't give it the five stars the story truly warrants.

I haven't found a trilogy that has sent me over the moon like Fifty Shades.....until now. THIS MAN TRILOGY is quite simply, delectably delicious and emotionally consuming. Let it be said that you MUST read the first two books in this series,Â This Man (This Man Trilogy)Â andÂ Beneath This Man (This Man Trilogy)Â in order to follow the plot line and to know what has transpired....but, gawd I loved this story...this third installation of THIS MAN TRILOGY.Jesse Ward..confident, arrogant, and sensual, and he knows it. He's fierce in his direct approach and uses all of his seductive traits to get what he wants...He can also be attentive, tender, soft and loving. And he loves Ava O'Shea more than life. He's never been in love before. He's never needed anyone before, and he has an extremely difficult time coping with this new, foreign emotion. But the longer these two main characters are together, the more Jesse learns proper behavior in a relationship. He learns how to give, and not just demand.Even though Jesse's self-absorbed, arrogant character is intense and his approach is forceful, I've got to admit I love how this Author flawlessly developed his character... Jesse has come such a long way since books 1 & 2.. He's a domineering, controlling arse, but he's also gentle, caring, loving and charming. I liked that he knew what he wanted and desperately goes after it (albeit not always in the wisest way). He's laid claim to Ava O'Shea. No matter what she says, no matter how she feels...she is HIS....End of!In this story, it was so refreshing to see Jesse being so open and honest. He finally speaks of his damaged past. He confesses how confused he was upon meeting Ava, as the feeling of wanting someone so passionately has never happened to him before. The feeling of NEEDING her was foreign. All of these harbored, confused thoughts and feelings are confessed...and so much more. He faces his vulnerabilities that Ava places on him and he sacrifices so much for her. My heart ached for Jesse. I adored him. He absolutely NEEDS Ava to survive. But he finally wins her...completely. They're determined to be unbreakable.There were many references to the first and second installment of this trilogy (THIS MAN)This Man (This Man Trilogy). Again, I highly recommend reading This Man (This Man Trilogy) before beginning this final book due to all the many event references from that first two books... just to avoid confusion or being lost.The only downside (if you wanna call it that) for me was.....for how possessive, controlling and careful Jesse is of Ava in her "condition"....I couldn't figure out WHY he still drives like a psycho maniac with her in the car- - it just seems like he'd be more like a Sunday driver with her in his car.....or WHY he never took her to the Dr. for her monthly baby check-ups.. - - he's the type that would want her having DAILY Dr. visits, lol. I dunno...this just seemed out of character for his domineering, controlling yet loving self.After finishing this book, I began the first book all over again. Just can't let Jesse and Ava go yet...

Jesse & Ava acting beyond the "childish" that we thought they could be capable of. I wish this brief but very irritating occurrence never happened.
