

Lots of examples of many techniques, set forth in a compelling page-turner! Superb read, and reference for anyone wanting to take their photography to the next level!

I bought a dslr camera a little over a year ago, and I've slowly been learning more about photography. This book is exactly what it promises to be--an overview of basic digital photography principles (like ISO, aperture and shutter speed) and a guide to boost the impact, artistry, and playfulness of the pictures you take.
