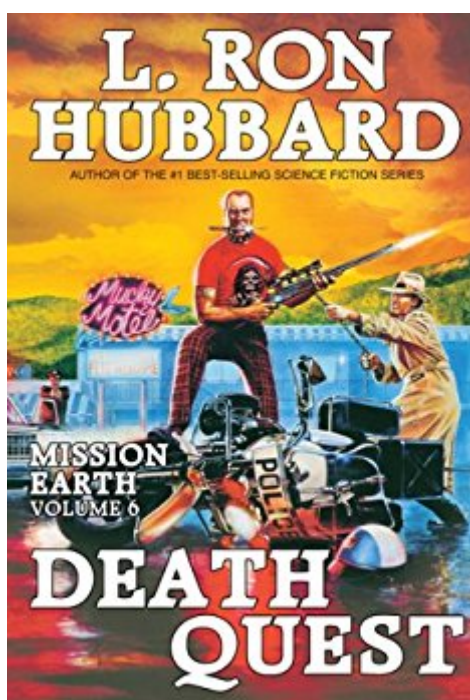

This series started out in typical L. Ron Hubbard style; unfortunately, since Volume 4, it's begun to spiral downward with Volume 6 off on a detour into sexual deviancy which frankly undermines and totally detracts from the story. I'm hoping it's going to get better.

I absolutely loved this satirical fictional description of the 10 tomes series of Mission Earth. The series is entertaining despite the fact that explanations of situations become a little wordy in some cases.
