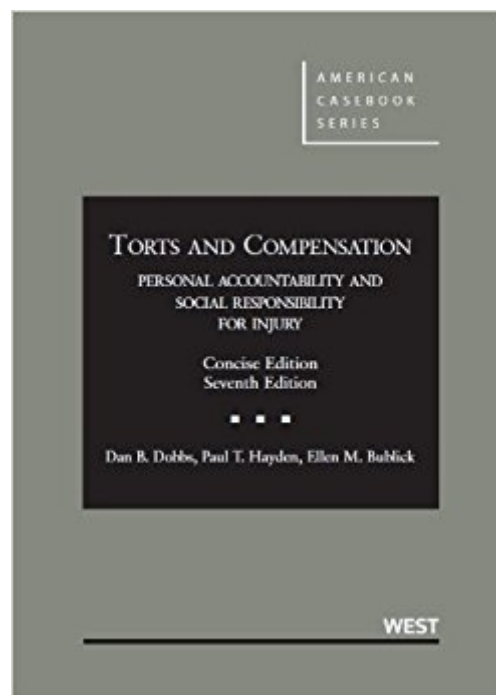

Synopsis

This version of Dobbs, Hayden and Bublick's Torts and Compensation is newly streamlined for professors who teach a four-unit course or who want to cover fewer pages per day, yet retain complete coverage. This edition tracks the standard edition, but cuts an additional 300 pages by removing some cases and notes and occasionally trimming a case to a shorter format. This edition also omits chapters concerning defamation, fraud, and other economic and dignitary torts, as well as some material concerning alternatives to Tort law. The result is a substantially shorter casebook that nevertheless provides the coverage most teachers want.

Be careful when ordering. This is the concise version, your professor may require the full version. Otherwise a fine casebook.

The differences between editions are not worth the heftier price tag. Buy the book for one cent.

Some decent wear and tare but that must mean it was used well!

Terrible textbook. Teaches legal theories not taught in 1L torts classes (such as misuse of government procedure), and avoids clarifying laws that are unclear (such as the gulf of differences in strict liability elements between 2nd and 3rd restatements). If a Torts professor is reading this and deciding on a casebook for their class: please refrain from Dobbs and go with Prosser, for the sake

of your students.
