This book was a really good source for research I have done for Civil War Reenacting. Great first hand accounts of civilian refugee life. This girl writes very well for her age. Good detail and entertainingly told.

I found it very interesting to see how she viewed the Civil War. Seeing the shelling and gunfire of the various battles in her area, I was able to connect with, liking history. Her family suffered, but during

the war, lots of people suffered, her family was just better off than most. It was hard to follow at times with all the guest coming and going from the houses she stayed in. As a diary, she did an excellent job penning her story. At some points, you couldn't wait to see what would happen next.

This first-hand account of the life of a Confederate girl is both interesting and a very informative source of historical facts. This book actually gave me a chance to see things from the other side of the conflict. Miss Sarah is a most eloquently spoken Southern Belle, and I am very grateful to have had the opportunity to read her diaries, thank Heavens they were never burned, as she originally intended for them!

As a life-long Civil War nerd, I've read many accounts of this fascinating four years. Primary source materials, like this diary, offer insights that have not been filtered by another writer or historian. While this book does not chronicle any significant battles, it does show the average civilian's struggles to endure the danger and privations of war. Some members of this Louisiana family are in the Union army, and the sixteen-year-old writer expresses an unusual refusal to believe that one side is either all bad or all good.

A young lady writes of her family's experience and trials during the Civil War. She is the calm one of the family which has split loyalties between Union and Confederates. The pace of life is steady during the earlier months, but as shortages develop it becomes more difficult. They eventually lose their lovely home and possessions and have many frightening times. Surprisingly well written as she shares her emotions .

A young woman whose father is a federal judge who declares for the Confederacy and has a brother who is federal judge and declares for the union. She lives in Baton Rouge. This is a journal of day to day events. The Union came and conquered. They became refugees. In time she and other family members take refuge in New Orleans with the brother. Other brothers die for the Confederacy. This is well written. A 15 year old with little education is quite literate. Some wonder if she could have done it. Either way it is worth the time spent reading. Of course I am reading diaries and memoirs from the civil war. Others might be less interested.

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
