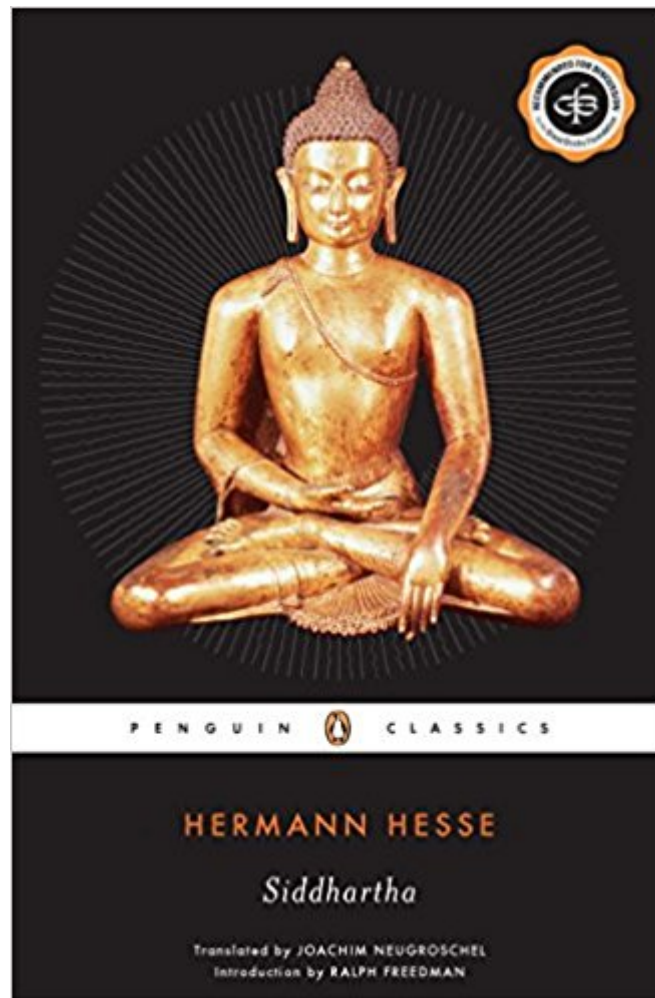




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Siddhartha: An Indian Tale (Penguin Twentieth-Century Classics)
