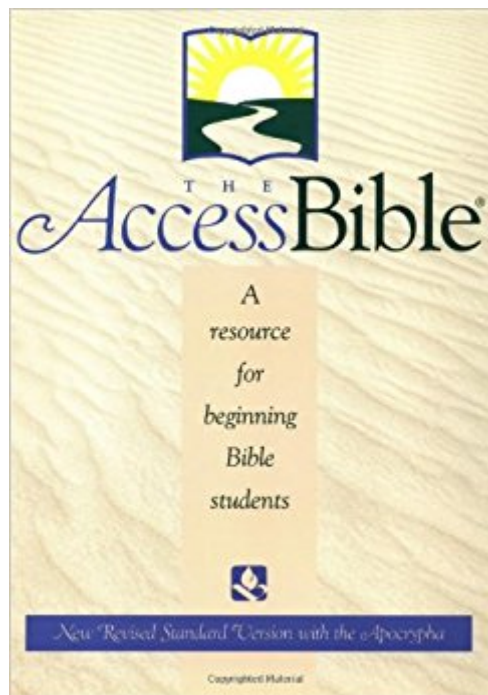

Synopsis

Modern readers of the Bible are time travelers visiting a society and culture very different from their own. When a technical explanation is required, all of the terms are defined right on the page, as well as in a glossary at the back. History, social contexts, religious practices, the beliefs of ancient peoples - all are explained when the Bible text requires it. In addition, this Bible was designed to contain all the background information needed by believers from a wide spectrum of churches. The Access Bible sets a new standard for ease of understanding.* Running commentary interspersed throughout the text provides on-the-spot explanatory and interpretative information. The Access Bible does what no other Bible in print has done: it marries impeccable, ideologically balanced scholarship with helpful annotations, sidebars, maps, and other study aids that first-time Bible readers need to understand what's going on. With apologies to the author of Ecclesiastes, this really is something new under the sun--a Bible that anyone, regardless of religious education, can pick up and read. It will neither talk down to you or make you feel you've gotten in over your head. The translation, the New Revised Standard Version, is the only contemporary translation that preserves the bones of the King James style and renders that style in straightforward language. The annotations, which appear in helpful places on the book's well-designed pages, also include a glossary and concordance to help readers understand and locate key terms in the Bible. The Access Bible makes reading the Bible as easy as it can be. Deciding what to do with all this knowledge, that's the hard part. (The Access Bible comes in several bindings, and is published in two different versions--one with the Apocrypha, a collection of writings endorsed by some denominations but not others--and one without.) --Michael Joseph Gross

The Access Bible is a study Bible for mainstream Christian believers. The study notes are comprehensive without giving extreme detail about information the average Bible reader probably doesn't care about. For example, in some study bibles, "town X was xxx miles from xxx, it's main industry was xxx, it was founded by xxx...." There seems to be a competition between the HarperCollins Study Bible and the New Oxford Annotated Bible (3rd and 4th editions) about which book has the most notes. These are both excellent, and I use both, but they are definitely written for the more scholarly crowd, whereas the Access Bible seem to be primarily written for believers---without dumbing down the material.

I have my own Access Bible and gave this one to a friend who had expressed a desire to gain a deeper understanding of the Old Testament passages she had been reading. This Bible is perfect for daily study as it is formatted to answer questions and offer explanations as you go rather than having to stop and consult footnotes. The notes appear after the passage and before you go to the

next section. I highly recommend this Bible and format not just for beginners, but for anyone interested in gaining a better understanding of the scriptures.

Very well done Bible. Especially recommended for those new to reading the Bible. At first, I wasn't sure that there was a need for a Bible of this type. But, the more I use it, the more I like it. It is especially useful to see the notes after reading a difficult passage. I have other Study Bibles. But, other Study Bibles are more secular - this Bible is "faith-based" yet has the latest scholarship. (Yes, I have some reservations about the NRSV's sometimes-clumsy attempts at gender inclusiveness. But, that is minor quibbling.) Great book !

This recent purchase is of the HARDBOUND edition, because the softbound edition was going to get destroyed by too much rough handling. The commentary in this edition is extremely helpful at placing passages in context with other scripture and with history. It does it in plain English, for which I am grateful.

Having annotations (i.e. explanations) in the text makes it much more meaningful when reading the Bible. In general, all my "huh? what did that mean?" questions have been answered.

I have a few bibles, but the AccessBible is my favorite for doing any kind of bible study work or just to read from. It's easy to understand & gives a lot of extra info. to give you a more clearer insite of what you read.

Included what I was after, including the Old Testament Apocrypha. Dictionay and concordance, although limited, is nice.
