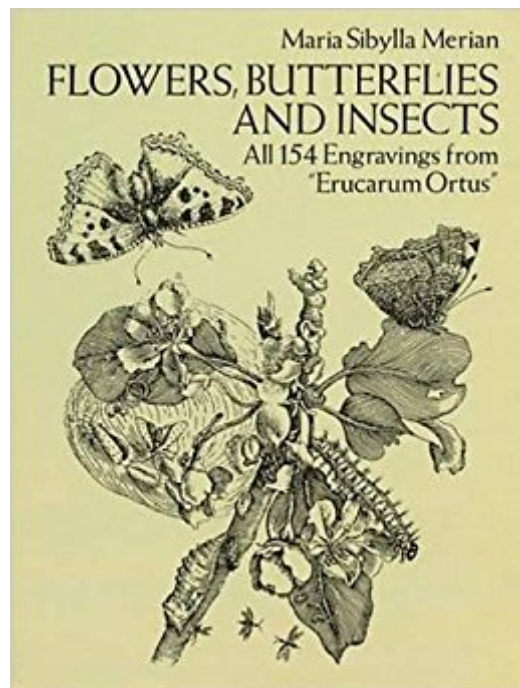




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Flowers, Butterflies And Insects: All 154 Engravings From "Erucarum Ortus" (Dover Pictorial Archive)
