

Usually am a fan of Lonely Planet, but this was disappointing. The book heavily highlights parts of Montreal that we found extremely touristy and not particularly interesting. We had such bad luck with a number of the recommended restaurants that after three meh overpriced experiences in a day or so we ditched the book in favor of Yelp and our own intuition and were much happier with the results.
