

Harter (Walking Through the Jungle) once again plunges into a flamboyantly hued jungle, and as the title hints, "the joint is jumpin'. With a cast of multi-ethnic children (including a wheelchair-bound girl) serving as guides, readers discover that all the inhabitants have rhythm, like the fluffy black bear with a purple nose who "goes shake, shake, boogie, woogie, oogie!" and a hooded red snake with blue polka dots who "goes slither, slither, boogie, woogie, oogie!" Harter offers up spirited animal characterizations on each spread: a wiry orange monkey swings through the sapphire sky, a lean saffron leopard covers two spreads in a single leap. The paper-over-board book's visual electricity, along with its irresistible repetition of the "oogie" sound and rollicking beat (a simple music score is included at the end of the book, so the text can be sung) make this a particularly good choice for a lively group with an itch to move. PreSchool-Grade 2-Filled with brilliant tropical colors, this lively picture book combines poetry, song, and dance into a dazzling and fun-packed guessing game. On one double spread, the text reads, "Down in the jungle, come if you dare! What can you see shaking here and there?" A clue in the illustration shows a boy peaking at an animal that is partly concealed by a large tree. A turn of the page reveals a bear that likes to dance: "Shake, shake, boogie, woogie, oogie! That's the way she's shaking here and there." A monkey, a leopard, an elephant, and several other creatures also move in their own particular ways. The rhythm of the text encourages children to boogie-woogie right along. The vivid illustrations, done in watercolor, crayon, and pen and ink, show lush jungle scenes, colorful animals, and a cast of smiling children. A simple musical score is included. Similar in tone to Harter's Walking through the Jungle (Orchard, 1997), this book makes a great choice for storyhours. The included CD can also be played on a computer and there is an animated version of the song (if you want a preview- look it up on YouTube). If you want a gateway book into Barefoot Books- try this one, especially if your child likes animals. We All Go Traveling By is a good one if your child likes cars/vehicles I have found that my children (6 and 3) argue and fight less in the car when we listen to books/ sing along books. Save your sanity and buy/borrow from the library this and other wonderful audio books

Yes, it is exhausting as an adult to have to be so repetitive, however, children find rhymes and repetition comforting and entertaining; aside from that, rhymes and repetition are excellent tools for speech development and for encouraging speech-delayed children to finish the phrases and repeat the sounds/words. My son is speech-delayed and we have three of these books because as tedious as it is for me to sing these books to him, they hold his interest, and they have been wonderful tools for us. I would recommend these to everyone, but especially to parents of speech-delayed children!! We also love We All Go Traveling By and Driving My Tractor from the same publisher.

This is a cute book with a sweet CD that children find engaging. I bought it for use during library classes I teach in a K-6 school. I use it with special education students because they need the music as well as the text to keep interested.
