

There are some very thoughtful reviews contained in the review section of on this book and there would be no point in repeating them. My perspective was how to use this book as an aid in leading my small group Bible study in the reading of Joshua. My goal was to do more than just review the historical aspects of the Joshua with the group and the Schaeffer book was perfect for expanding the group discussion far beyond those historical aspects. It has given me the sound foundation needed to provide the group with the knowledge needed on how Joshua fits into the bigger picture of redemption as laid out in the Bible. This books makes it relatively easy to explain the meaning of continuity within the Bible and I believe, will give this group some real insight into the bigger picture so that all of those in the group will be more effective advocates in advancing the word of the Lord.
