

This book needs a good editing by someone familiar with the cattle industry. It is full of little mistakes. For example, it says cattle are branded with a "red hot" iron (not so). It says that cowboy became unhappy having to do "hay bailing (sic)". Hay balers were barely invented by the 1880s and hardly common in the west. Many more mistakes can be found, which makes one wonder about whether the author did adequate research and whether the publisher edited thoroughly. None the less, it is an interesting read..
