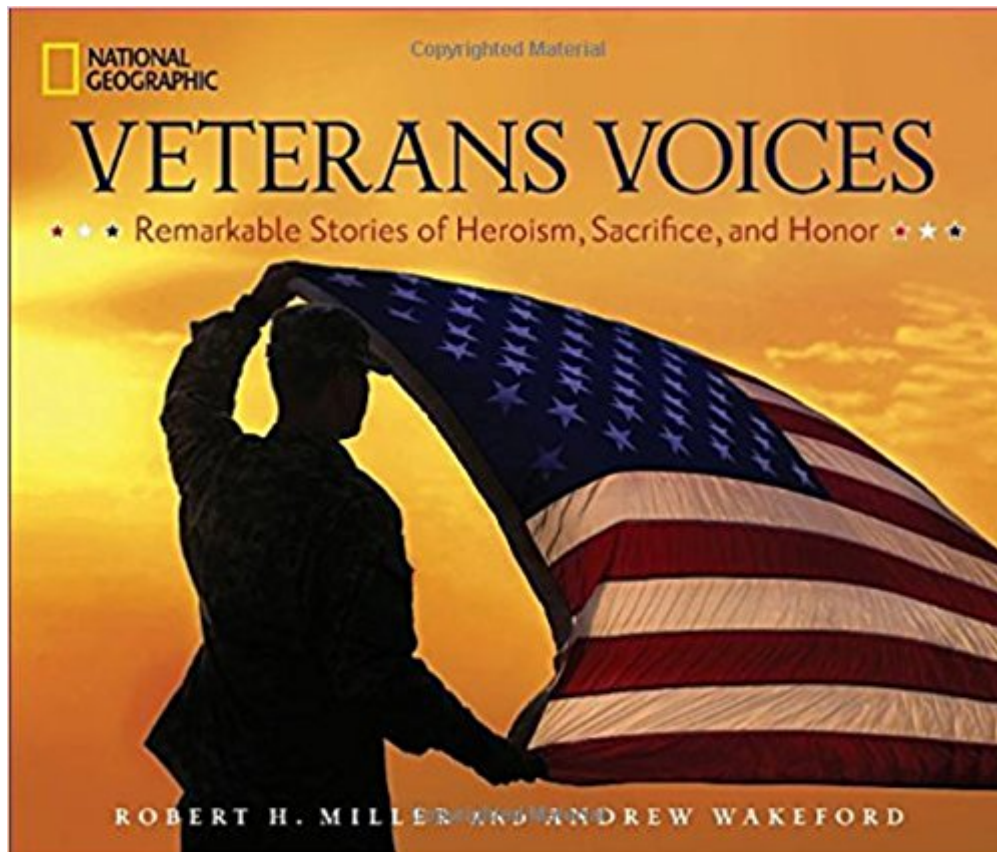




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Veterans Voices: Remarkable Stories Of Heroism, Sacrifice, And Honor

Robert Miller and Andrew Wakefield's VETERANS VOICES, REMARKABLE STORIES OF HEROISM, SACRIFICE AND HONOR is a collection of stories of 70 American servicemen and servicewomen told by the veterans themselves. A 2016 National Geographic release, VETERANS VOICES presents a compelling and inspiring vision of Americans at war. The stories are divided into sections on Inspiration, Courage, Resilience, Duty and so on. Many of the veterans covered in the book served in Iraq and Afghanistan although there are vets from WWII, Korea, the Cold War,

Vietnam and other locales. The write-ups range from two to four pages with one or more photographs including a color portrait of the veteran. The stories, some of them quite affecting, often describe combat, death and injury but nevertheless offer an uplifting message. Even when horribly wounded and disabled, those men and women have risen above the setbacks and continued on. VETERANS VOICES is, at once, a you-are-there history of Americans at war and a heartwarming tribute to those veterans who fought for our country in some many locales and conflicts.
